

UBE Umbraco: Google Map Macro

This macro displays a Google map with a marker in your chosen position.

Nb: on an Apple Mac, right click = Ctrl (control) + click.

	Instruction	Comment
1	Open the Content tab of the page on which the map is to be displayed.	
2	In the page's Grid Layout, decide where the map is to be positioned.	The map will fill the width of the column in which it is placed.
3	Click the big "+" at the bottom of the column that will contain the map and click "Macro"	A panel will display on the right hand side.
4	Select the "Google map" macro from the drop-down menu.	The panel refreshes showing several parameters
5	Complete the "Postcode" or "Longitude/latitude" field.	If both are completed, the "Longitude/Latitude" field will be used. To get the longitude and latitude of a location: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open www.google.co.uk/maps. 2. Browse to the required location. 3. Right click on the exact location and, in the menu that displays, click "What's here?" 4. In the small panel that displays near the bottom of the page, click on the longitude and latitude. 5. The map refreshes with a marker at the location. Copy and paste the longitude and latitude from the top of the panel on the left.
6	Enter a number of pixels to fix the height of the map.	The width of the map will be set automatically to the width of the column. The default value for the height is 400 pixels.
7	Enter a value to set the map's zoom	The default is 15. Set a value between 10 and 20.
8	Click "Select" in the bottom right hand corner	
9	Click "Preview" to preview the page and check your map settings.	To adjust the settings, click just inside the dotted box containing the macro to open the parameters' panel (not on the map or it will open in a new window).
10	Click "Save and publish".
